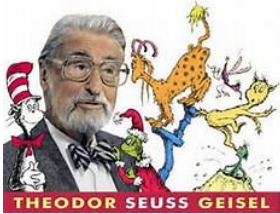

- Birds of all kinds will be the focus of all our Shared Reading, Reading Booklets, Art, and Center Activities.

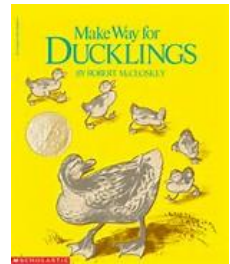
