- Plants and the lifecycle of a seed will be the focus of all our Shared Reading, Reading Booklets, Art, and Center Activities.

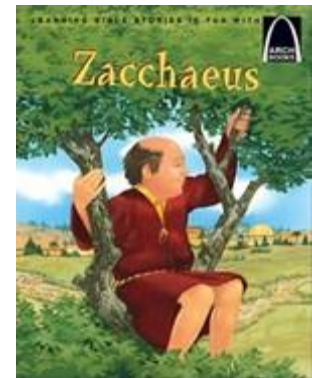


- We will read several versions of “Jack and the Beanstalk” and create a large paper beanstalk and giant legs crashing through our ceiling. We will compare and contrast 2 of these versions with a venn diagram.

- We will watch bean seeds germinate and hopefully grow our own beanstalk.

- We will learn the parts of a flower as we explore real flowers and create and label an artistic diagram.

- We will observe the job of a stem as we place white carnations in colored water.
- In Math we will introduce the concept of half and whole with objects and groups of objects. We will also introduce the quarter.
- Zacchaeus climbing the sycamore tree to see Jesus will be our Bible story this month.



- We will gather the final tallies and numbers of postcards. How many cards did we receive all year? Which state had the most cards? Did we receive a card from all 50 states?
